E-Agriculture goes beyond technology, to promote the integration of technology with multimedia, knowledge and culture. Facilitation, support of standards and norms, technical support, capacity building, education, and extension are all key components to a Agriculture.



education, and extension are all key components to e-Agriculture. There are several types of activity related to e-agriculture applications that are widely recognized around the world today. The delivery of agricultural information and knowledge services (i.e. market prices, extension services, etc.) using the Internet and related technologies falls under the definition of e-Agriculture. More advanced applications of e-agriculture in farming exist in the use of sophisticated ICTs such as satellite systems, Global Positioning Systems (GPS), advanced computers and electronic systems to improve the quantity and quality of agricultural production. Junagadh Agricultural University, Junagadh is the first Agricultural University of Gujarat, which made community FM Radio Station 'Junagadh Janvaani' which was launched by the Hon'ble Chief Minister of Gujarat Smt. Anandiben Patel, during the Mega Event of Krushi Mahotsav 2015 celebrated at Shihor on May 5, 2015. This will facilitate dialogue between farmers and experts which is the best example for e-Agriculture made possible by JAU, Junagadh.

Information and communication technologies have tremendous impact on the rural economy due to their wide application. Nevertheless, there are many efforts in India to demonstrate the concrete benefits of ICT for rural population and to carry out the same in a manner that makes economic sense. There are some advantages of ICT in E-agriculture benefitted to the farmers in following ways:

- It can initiate new agricultural and rural business such as e-commerce, real estate business for satellite offices, rural tourism and virtual corporation of small-scale farms.
- It can support policy making and evaluation on optimal farm production, disaster management, agro-environmental resource management etc., using tools such as geographic information systems (GIS).
- It can improve farm management and farming technologies by efficient farm management, risk management, effective information and knowledge transfer etc.
- It can provide systems and tools to secure food traceability and reliability that has been an emerging
 issue concerning farm products since serious contamination such as chicken flu was detected.
- It can facilitate rural activities and provide more comfortable and safe rural life such as provision of distant education, telemedicine, remote public services, remote entertainment etc.
- Empowerment of stakeholders
- Development of Knowledge Management, Decision Support and Advisory Systems to strengthen Extension services and also used for Farmers Redressed system.
- · Efficient management of resources.
- Improved productivity and profitability.

JAU, Junagadh Janvani 91.2 FM Community Radio Station for farmers

Shri Mohanbhai Kundaria, Union Minister of State for Agriculture, Government of India, launched the Broadcasting Ceremony of Junagadh Janvani 91.2 FM, a newly established Community Radio Station of JAU for farmers on June 23, 2015, in the auspicious presence of Shri Jashabhai Barad, Hon'ble Minister of Agriculture (State), Government of Gujarat; Dr. A. R. Pathak, Hon'ble Vice Chancellor, JAU, Junagadh; MP; MLA;, Mayor etc remained present. JAU is the first Agricultural University of Gujarat, which has started such community radio station service for the farmers. In his presidential address, Shri Mohanbhai Kundaria appreciated the efforts made by the University for making such unique service for the farmers. This radio station service is available in Junagadh city and 15 km of surrounding area covering about 70 villages. The main broadcast takes place at 7.30 am daily, with re-broadcast at 5.30 pm. RESEARCH

11th Combined Joint AGRESCO-2015 Meeting of SAUs held at Anand Agricultural University, Anand, during April 07-09, 2015. Eight new varieties, 45 recommendations for farmers, 32 scientific information and 66 new technical programmes were approved during plennary session of this meeting.

Varieties/hybrids released Gujarat Junagadh Gram 6

This variety has yielded (1867 kg/ha) 13.6, 21.9 and 5.2 per cent higher over checks viz; Gujarat Gram 1, Gujarat Gram 2 and Gujarat Junagadh Gram 3, respectively. Seeds of this variety are of medium size and dark brown in colour with 19.9 per cent protein. This variety is resistant to wilt and stunt diseases. It is recommended for release in Gujarat.

Gujarat Junagadh Long Brinjal 4

This variety has recorded a mean fruit yield of 396.03 q/ha, which was 30.81 and 25.83 per cent higher over check varieties GOB 1 and GBL 1, respectively. The little leaf disease, Jassids, white fly and fruit borer were less as compared to check variety



GOB1. The fruit of GJB 4 are medium in size with long shape and light purple colour with good shining. It is recommended for release in Gujarat.

Gujarat Junagadh Brinjal Hybrid 3

This variety gave a mean fruit yield of 428.01 q/ha, which was 14.11 and 25.68 per cent higher over hybrid checks GBH 2 (375.08 q/ha) and ABH 1 (340.57 q/ha), respectively. It has recorded 6.63 and 7.66 per cent higher

fruit yield than private hybrids Navina (VNR Seeds) and ARBH 201 (Ankur Seeds), respectively. The little leaf disease (4.42%) was less as compared to check variety GBH 2 (4.98%). The damage due to jassids (2.84/leaf), white fly (3.93/leaf) and fruit borer (4.93 %) were less as compared to hybrid checks. The protein (1.48%) and total soluble sugar (3.33%) were more as



compared to hybrid checks. The fruit of this hybrid are medium in size with oblong shape and pink purple colour with good shine. It is recommended for release in Gujarat.

Gujarat Junagadh Sponge Gourd 2

This variety has recorded fruit yield of 114.04 q/ha, which was 18.05 and 19.18 percent higher than check variety GSG 1 and National check Pusa Chikni. Further mosaic, downey mildew score, fruit fly damage and leaf miner larvae were less as compared to check varieties. The fruit of GJSG 2 are long in size,




green colour with good shine. It is recommended for release in Gujarat.

Gujarat Junagadh Okra Hybrid 4

This hybrid recorded a mean fruit yield of 135.94 q/ha, which was 46.91 and 23.86 percent higher over check variety and hybrid GJOH3 respectively. It also yielded 17.11, 28.04 and 30.69 per cent higher yield over one private check HOK 12 and two public sector checks Arka Anamika and Pusa Sawani, respectively. The yellow vein

mosaic was found less as compared to check variety GOH 2. The jassids, thrips, white fly and fruit borer damage were less than check varieties. The fruits of this hybrid are medium, dark green tender, long and attractive. It is recommended for release in Gujarat.



Gujarat Junagadh Til 5

This variety recorded seed yield of 1241 kg/ha

which was 22.39 per cent higher than the check variety GT 3. Oil yield of this variety was 22.22 per cent higher than GT 3. It matures in 91 days and contains 46.98 per cent oil, which are white in colour and bolder in size. This variety was released for summer season cultivation in Gujarat.

Gujarat Junagadh Pigeonpea 1 (Area expansion)



This variety has produced 2115 kg/ha, seed yield which was 38.78, 10.06, 27.62 and 21.16 per cent higher over check varieties, BDN 2, ICPL 87119, Vaishali and AGT 2 respectively. This variety is medium late (176 days) in maturity, GJP 1 is also found moderately resistant to wilt (13.89%) and SMD (13.89%) disease. The seed of this variety is bold in size with white colour. It is recommended for release in Gujarat.

- 2. Field Development Manager, Bayer Crop Science Ltd, Pune has approved project "Evaluation of Bio-efficacy of CYCLANILIDE-22% + MEPIQUAT CHLORIDE-88% (110 SC) in kharif Groundnut" at the Main Oilseeds Research Station, JAU, Junagadh with a total outlay of Rs. 7.73 lakh for two year..
- 3. Research Project entitled "Modeling Water and Energy Fluxes over Forest System (Gir Forest)" at College of Agril. Engg. & Tech., JAU, Junagadh through involvement of M.Tech. & Ph. D. students (Ag. Engg. subject) for two years i.e. April-2015 to March-2017 with the Space Application Center (SAC), ISRO, Ahmedabad.



Special Cleanliness drive organized under "Swachh **Bharat Mission**"





A Journey of VCI, New Delhi recognized Veterinary College, Junagadh towards development......


Veterinary College, Junagadh is recognized by the Veterinary Council of India (VCI) vide notification-The Gazette of India published by MoA, Govt. of India, New Delhi-F.No. 52-01/2015-LDT (VC) dated Feb 19, 2015 and has been included in Schedule-I by the VCI, New Delh., after examining the all necessary infrastructural facilities developed by the JAU as per the norms and requirements of VCI. From this academic year, the B.V.Sc. & A.H. degree course intake capacity is increased from 40 to 60 seats whereas the PG intake capacity is 36 and inservice PG programmes are also run for teachers. As per VCI norms, total seventeen departments are functioning in the College. In addition to this, a three year diploma course of Polytechnic in Animal Husbandry with an intake




