

Hon'ble Vice Chancellor's Message

It is expected that by the year 2050, India will be the most populous country in the world, with a population of about 2.0 billion. Hence, the strategy is to enhance production to meet per capita minimum dietary requirements by developing the crop varieties enriched with specific nutritional diversity. Horticultural crops, *viz.*, fruits, vegetables, ornamentals, medicinal crops, plantation crops and mushrooms play an important role in improving food, nutritional, health and livelihood security and the country's economy in the coming days. There has been a steady and rapid expansion in area, production and utilization of horticultural crops in India, facilitated by technology-driven scientific support through concerted research.

Despite impressive research achievements and support to developmental activities by the Government of India, horticulture in India is dogged by several constraints such as low productivity, depleting land resources and degraded production environment, crop losses due to peat and diseases, post harvest losses and value addition, changing quality consciousness and global competition, climate change, inadequate market linkage and price fluctuations, etc. that need to be tackled appropriately bearing in mind the fragile natural resources, coupled with expected climatic aberrations for long-term sustainable farming technologies, using the following approaches.



- Increasing productivity and quality of horticultural crops through genetic enhancement and development of sustainable integrated crop management practices
- Production and supply of quality planting material of horticultural crops
- * Effective utilization of natural resources and enhancement of input use efficiency
- Integrated insect pest, soil and water management
- · Post-harvest management and value-addition, and
- Technology transfer, adoption and impact assessment; commercialization and popularization of technologies developed in horticultural research.



A unique case of foetal hydrocephalus preserved in museum

A nine year old Jaffarabadi buffalo in her first parity and approximate nine month pregnancy with history of dystocia from Keshod Taluka was presented to the Teaching Veterinary Clinical Complex, CoVS & AH, JAU, Junagadh. During manual obstetrical examination, the cervix was found fully open with the huge fluid filled in the head, marked enlargement of the cranium was felt and foetal extremities were very difficult to palpate was diagnosed as dystocia due to foetal hydrocephalus. Dead male fetus was delivered through cesarean section by team, Dr. K. H. Parmar, Dr. R. J Raval and Dr. K. B. Vala of Department of Veterinary Gynaecology & Obstetrics, CoVS&AH, JAU, Junagadh. The case was preserved in the Dept. museum.

Intramedullary pinning in a hanuman langur and cataract surgery in a dog

Under C-arm guided fluoroscopy, intramedullary pinning was performed to immobilize the simple, transverse, diaphyseal, humerus fracture in a common hanuman langur (Macaca mullata). Further, an extra capsular cataract surgery of right eye was performed on a 9 years old German shepherd male dog under inhalant anaesthesia (3% isoflurane) with the help of operating microscopeat Department of Veterinary Surgery and Radiology, College of Veterinary Science and Animal Husbandry, JAU, Junagadh. Dr. J. V. Vadalia, Dr. Vineet Kumar and Dr. V. D. Dodia performed both the surgeries under guidance of Dr. P. B. Patel. Uneventful recovery was recorded in both the cases.
