
About the organizing Department:

Junagadh Agricultural University (JAU) is one of the leading State Agricultural Universities in India. Established in 2004 as a separate University from the erstwhile Gujarat Agricultural University, JAU is fast establishing its footprints in addressing the emerging challenges in agriculture and ship-shaping the state's agricultural policy orientation.

Department of Horticulture of University have a brief history. Before independence, the horticultural activities were weighted by *Nawab* of Junagadh state and has their own horticulturist to develop and maintain gardens. But after independence, the responsibility of horticulture was given to Department of Agriculture newly established by Gujarat state and also established College of Agriculture (1960-61) with separate Department of Horticulture. The Professor & Head of the department was the subject matter specialist (SMS) of horticulture for whole state. The full-fledged Department of Horticulture was started with multi-functional activities like Teaching, Research and Extension education during 1972 with the inception of Gujarat Agricultural University as an autonomous body. Since May 2004 after bifurcation of GAU, the Department is working as a part of College of Agriculture under Junagadh Agriculture University. Department is working for impatiens the horticultural shining for the students and farmers.

Teaching and research is the mandatory task of the Department of Horticulture. Right from the inception of the Department in 1960, lot off work has been done including research recommendations for the farmers, release of varieties, post graduate research as well as awarding the degrees to M. Sc. and Ph.D. students 284 & 50, respectively. The department is also offering courses to the tune of 8 for B.Sc. (Agri), 29 for B. Sc. (Hort) and 25 for M. Sc. (Hort.) for both agriculture and horticulture colleges. The alumni of the department are working in various capacities in academics, banking, line departments, private concerns and NGOs.





About the training programme:

This training programme will be conducted under the aegis NAHEP-IDP, a project being operated at the University funded by World Bank for improving the overall competency of the undergraduate students of the University along with strengthening the existing industry-academia liaison and improving entrepreneurial inclination among the students. Accordingly, the specific objectives of the intended training programme are as follows:

- 1. To improving awareness, entrepreneurial and skills of the undergraduate students in modern techniques of processing and value addition in various horticultural crops for a rewarding career ahead.
- 2. Use of instruments and their general upkeep/maintenance, interpretation of analytical data and formulation of reports/recommendations.
- 3. The training is designed to different post-harvest techniques, management and methods of preparation of various recipes, packaging, marketing, so as to make it more useful in the context of business competition in quality.
- 4. Perform task with due consideration to safety rules, accident prevention regulations and environmental protection stipulations.




